1. Review of January 2022 action list

C. Frybort is waiting to hear from the Public Library Services Branch, (PLSB), regarding the 'No Refund' policy changes.

Laminating fee has been added to a draft of the board schedule document. As of February 14th, the library offers this service.

3. Covid update

C. Frybort included a brief Covid update in the Library Director report. Some restrictions have lifted. Patrons are allowed to have beverages in the library, and more seating will be available in the library soon.

4. Report from council - L. Hansen

Council received feedback from citizens regarding scooters in Leduc. The survey resulted in 55% of the people for and 45% against. Council passed the first bylaw reading.

An RCMP inspector reported to council that overall, crime in Leduc is down 9%.

Economic development is improving. There has been increased use of commercial property in industrial areas.

Leduc growth has slowed but it is still one of the fastest growing municipalities in the country. Current population is over 34,000.

Council will be working on Strategic Planning, Saturday, February 26th.

It is likely there will be a local census conducted this year.

5. Round Robin

- T. Tijani: asks the duties expected for members of the staff relations committee. C. Frybort responds that an employee may approach the committee with a concern if unable to approach the library director. In the past, J. Storeshaw and A. Braithwaite had looked at work conditions at the library. Discussion.
- D. Matthews: asks C. Frybort about this weeks YRL executive meeting. YRL executive met with the auditors regarding a draft financial statement. YRL is collaborating with a consultant on a draft for a new strategic plan for next year. K. Palichuk, (YRL director), would like to give a presentation to our board this year, in the fall.
- C. Frybort: the library H & S committee will get a quote on an AED machine to present to the trustees. C. Frybort met with T. Turner regarding the sign project for the library. C. Frybort is hoping a sign will be in place this fall. More information will be available the next board meeting. Art Berkholtz donated a hand made wooden replica of the Leduc Grain Elevator to the library. The Government of Alberta is looking to open the Libraries Act to make changes.
- T. Turner: The Maclab Centre received an unexpected \$35,000 grant from the Canadian Heritage Foundation. Future grant submissions will require groups to submit a succession plan. Leduc Community Development and the Culture department are working with the provincial community development unit. T. berry will be joining some Leduc and Beamont library staff for a tour at the Energy Museum next week. The library and the city's H & S department will be working together on safety in the building.
